
- India is second largest fruit producer after China

- Only 0.5% share in global fruit export
- Worldwide most traded tropical fruits are Banana,
 Pineapple, Mango, and Avacado
- India is a top producer of Banana and Mango




Production share of different fruits in India








Top 10 Exporting country for product : Fresh Grapes

- Introduction of Dogridge rootstock
- Standardization of schedules of growth regulators
- Introduction of Varieties : Flame Seedless, 2A clone, Crimson Seedless, Red Globe etc.
- Electrostatic spraying system
- Establishment of Referral Lab for residue monitoring
- Bio-intensive disease management
- Location specific Disease Management advisory based on weather information.
- Plastic cover for protection from rain and hail storms






Pomegranate Area (x 1000 ha) Global Scenario

Pomegranate scenario in India 2011-2022











Percent increase in pomegranate area, production and export during last 11 (2011-22) years in India




