

GORT 2022 – Publication guidelines for presenters

We have important announcements on the above:

1. **Abstracts of papers & posters:** It has been decided to publish the abstracts of the presentations and posters at the GORT 2022 as a souvenir that will be shared with all attendees to the conference. This will be published by ATPBR in collaboration with the Society for Horticultural Research & Development (SHRD), Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh (India).
2. **Full papers:** We have approached Springer Nature and they have in principle agreed to publish all papers as a book provided all speakers accept to publish their presentations.

Following are the guidelines

Poster, Abstract, Full-length Article Submission Guidelines

Other than the invited speakers, we encourage graduate, post-graduate students, scientists, breeders, and other professionals who are working with Okra to submit an abstract of their posters for presentation at the GORT 2022. All invited speakers are requested to send their abstracts as well as full papers as per guidelines below.

Submission rules before submitting the abstracts:

1. All selected abstracts by a selection committee will be invited for the poster presentation, and will be published in the book with Springer Nature.
2. The presenting author should be available on the date and time scheduled for poster presentation
3. All posters **MUST** be displayed throughout the conference from Monday, October 10 through Wednesday, October 12, 2022.
4. The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission
5. The presenting author must be listed as the first author
6. Submitted abstracts should include original and non-published data
7. Abstracts previously presented will not be accepted.
8. All abstracts should be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.
9. More than one abstract for the poster presentation will be accepted if found innovative in content
10. All abstracts accepted for presentation will be published on the Conference website prior to the Conference
11. All abstracts of the Conference will be published in the form of souvenir book
12. Please note the submitting author will receive all correspondence about the abstract so we advise that the submitting author details that are entered in the abstract are the same details as those of the presenting author
13. Abstracts may not be edited/updated after final submission. You are welcome to bring an updated abstract onsite with you

Guidelines for submission for publishing full length article in the book by Springer Nature

1. Presenting author's contact details (should be the same details as the submitting author so that the presenting author receives the correspondence about the abstract.
2. Author and Co-author's details
 - a. Email address
 - b. Full Postal Address
 - c. Phone number
 - d. Full first and family name
 - e. Affiliation details: department, institution, city, state (if relevant), country
3. Abstract title – limited to 20 words
4. Abstract text (**limited to 250 words**): Do not include your title and author information as part of the abstract body. If you copy and paste text, it should be from a standard Microsoft Word document. Tables and graphics are not recommended in abstract.
5. Abstract layout - Abstracts must be submitted with the following sections:
 - a. Objective
 - b. Methods
 - c. Results
 - d. Conclusion
6. As all papers presented by speakers will be published as full article, they are requested to provide written consent along with their article. Consent will be required to publish the full-length article as a book chapter in an edited book, published with Springer Nature after the conference.
7. Submit your abstract or full-length article via email at secygort1@gmail.com
8. Once an abstract or full-length research paper is submitted, the only means of communication and notification of status will be sent via e-mail. Only the primary author will be sent a letter of notification indicating the acceptance or rejection of an abstract via the e-mail provided. It is incumbent on the submitter to notify all authors of the decision.
9. Please note that the full-length article along with abstract must be SUBMITTED before the deadline (September 10, 2022) to be sent to review for inclusion in the book
